

Both District Water Reclamation Facilities win NACWA Awards

The Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District has again been selected to receive two Peak Performance Awards. The Peak Performance Awards program presented by the National Association of Clean Water Agencies (NACWA) recognizes public wastewater treatment facilities for their outstanding compliance records in the 2009 calendar year. NACWA recognized each of SBWRD's two facilities during NACWA's Summer Conference, July 20-23, 2010 in San Francisco, CA.

The Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District's <u>East Canyon Water Reclamation</u> <u>Facility</u> and <u>Silver Creek Water Reclamation Facility</u> each received Peak Performance Platinum Awards, which honors treatment works that have achieved 100 percent compliance with their NPDES permit for five (5) or more consecutive years. The District's <u>East Canyon Water Reclamation Facility</u> received a Peak Performance Platinum Award Six for six (6) years of consecutive 100 percent compliance and the <u>Silver Creek Water Reclamation Facility</u> received a Peak Performance Platinum Award Seven for seven (7) years of consecutive 100 percent compliance.
