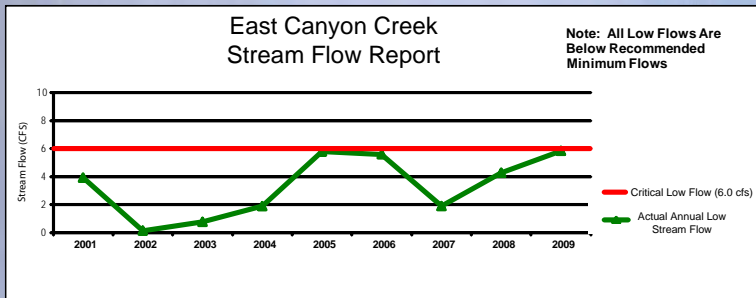


Stream Flow Report

By Saving our Snow not only do we impact our local economy but also our environment. This report is provided to inform the public on the issues surrounding the East Canyon Creek Watershed. The expanding population of the Park City area has resulted in very low amounts of water flowing in the stream. Reduced snowfall will make this situation worse. When the flow in East Canyon Creek drops below a certain level, native Bonneville Cutthroat Trout and other trout populations cannot survive.

The graph below gives an overview of our local stream flow along with the critical low flow level. The Utah Division of Wildlife Resources has advised that a minimum flow of 6.0 cfs (cubic feet per second) is needed for fish habitat.
