As you are well aware, the declaration of candidacy period begins tomorrow, June 1st. Below are upcoming deadlines, information about candidates being out of town, and financial disclosure reporting. Refer to last week's update for information about office hours during the declaration period and the materials you need to provide candidates.

Upcoming Election Deadlines

- **June 1, 2017** - Declaration of candidacy period begins. Post candidates' names, contact info, and the office they are seeking on the municipality's website within 3 days.
- **June 7, 2017** - Declaration of candidacy period ends at 5:00 pm.
- **June 8, 2017** - Email the list of candidates to the Lt. Governor's Office (elections@utah.gov) and the county clerk.
- **June 8, 2017** - Publish the list of candidates in two successive publications of a newspaper. See [20A-9-203\(10\)](#).
