**MONTHLY
“FLUSH INDEX”**

PARK CITY, UT. (October 14, 2020) -- The Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District calculates a monthly “flush Index” for the purpose of estimating the number of visitors (visitor nights) that were present in the Park City/Snyderville Basin area. Listed below is the latest monthly index with a comparison from the previous year.

September 2020 Visitor Nights “Flush Index”	% Difference from September 2019
341,485 +/-	18.2% Decrease

The “Flush Index” is based on historical wastewater flows measured by the Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District. Actual methodology involves a statistical model that considers the quantity of wastewater, the strength of wastewater, monthly visitation patterns and an adjustment for rain or snow melt water seeping into the system.
